- Then click on Connect a Device

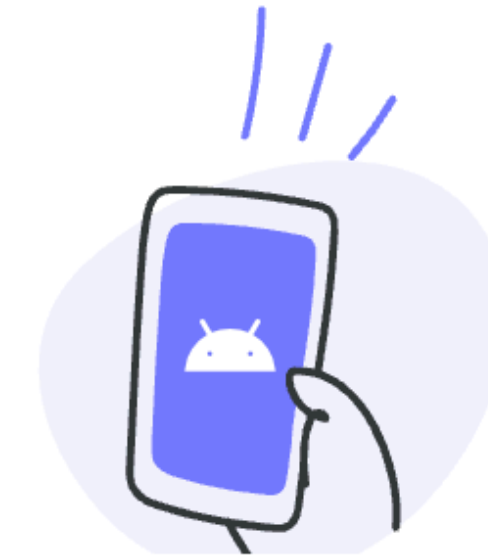

1 - Open Google Play on your child's Android

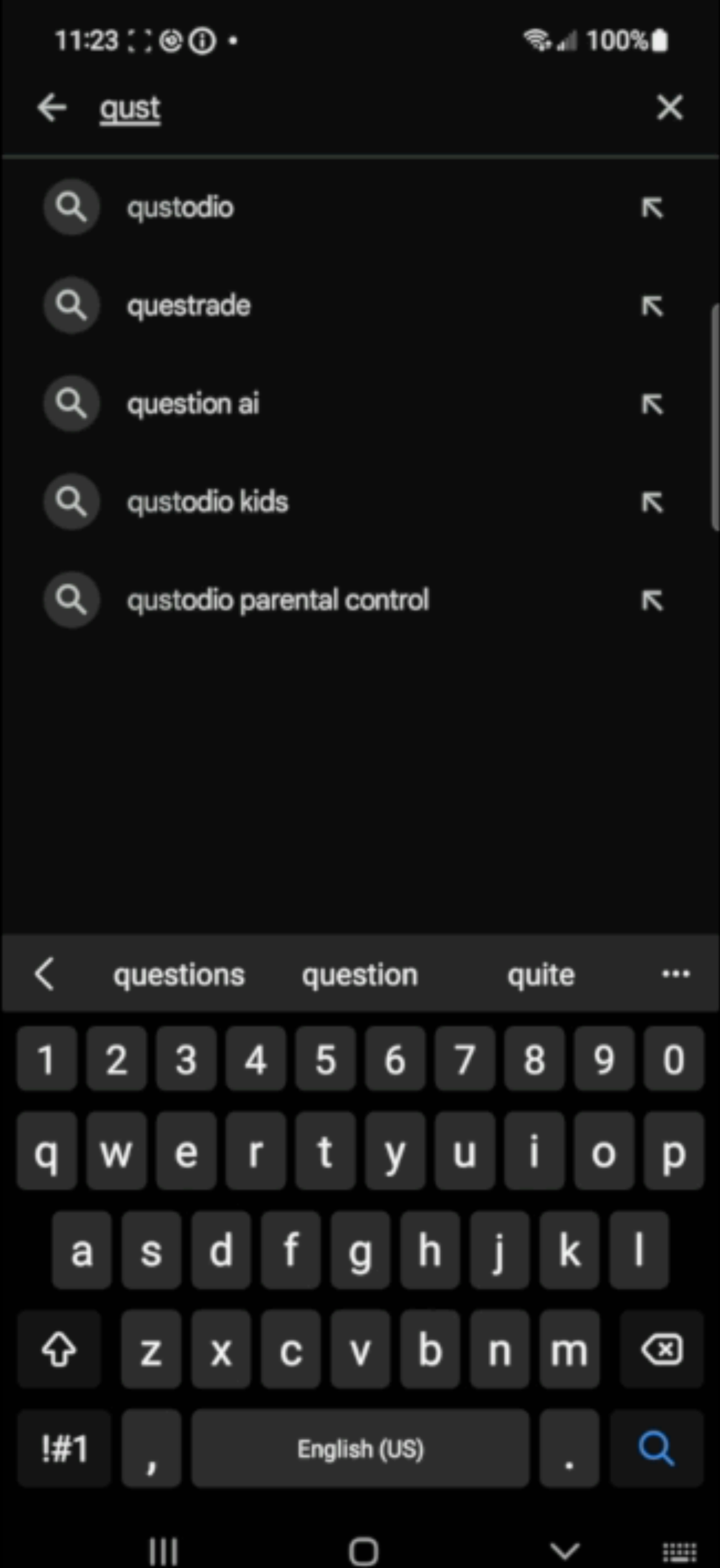

- follow the steps on screen.

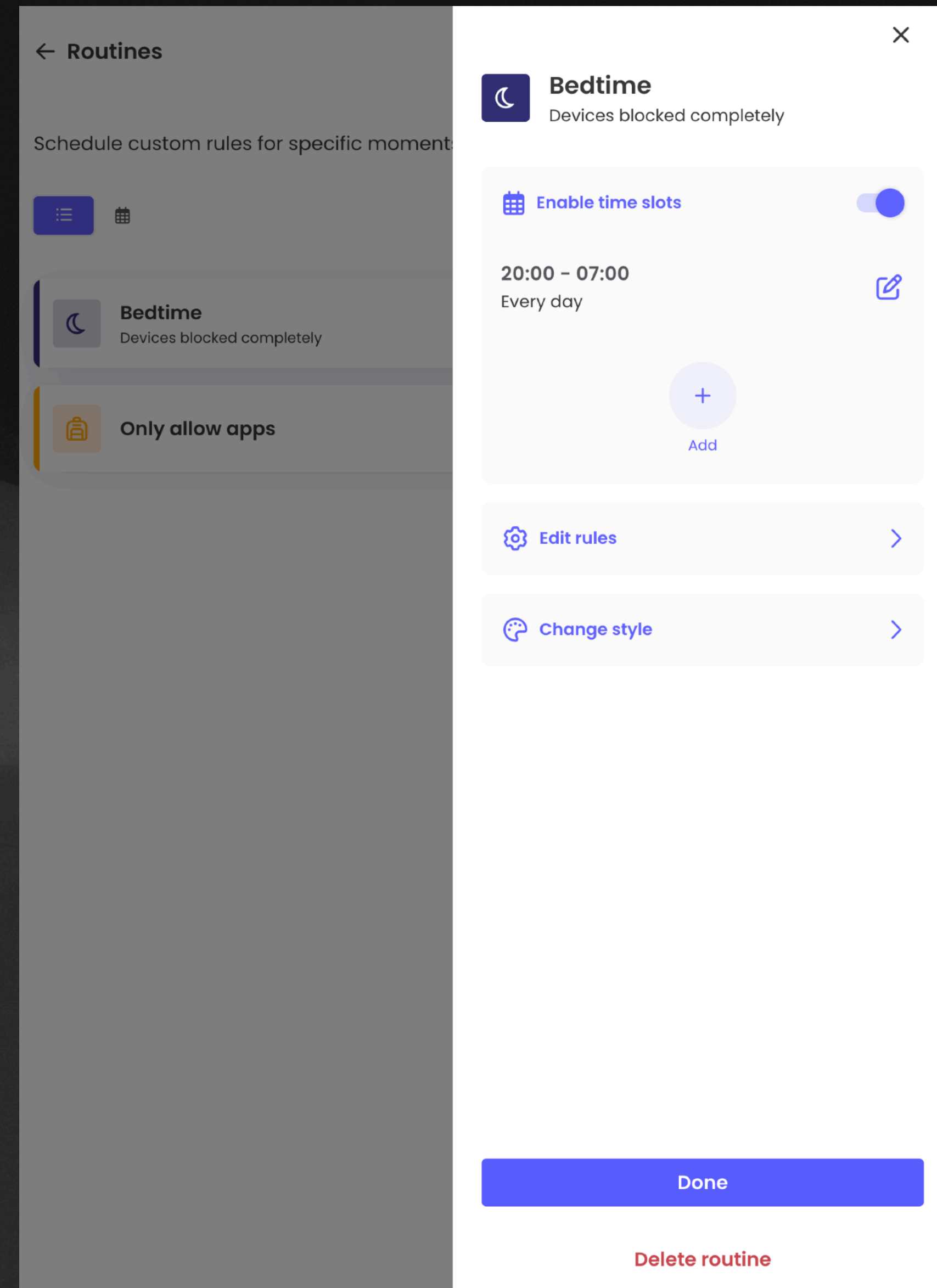
App Install Process



Recommended Settings

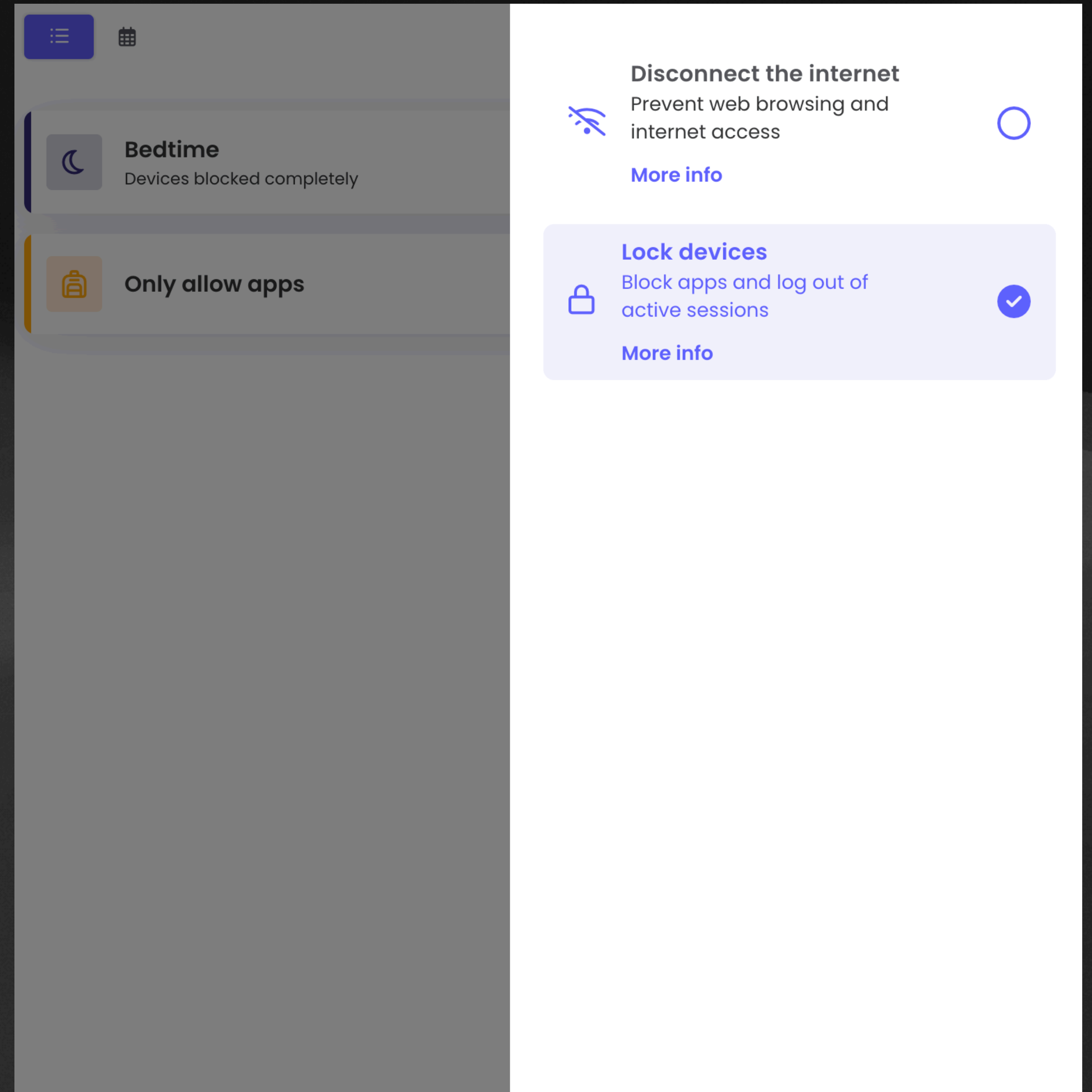
Daily Downtime

- Go to My family > [child's name] > Rules > Routines
- Select Bedtime or Add Routine and select Bedtime
- Set schedule



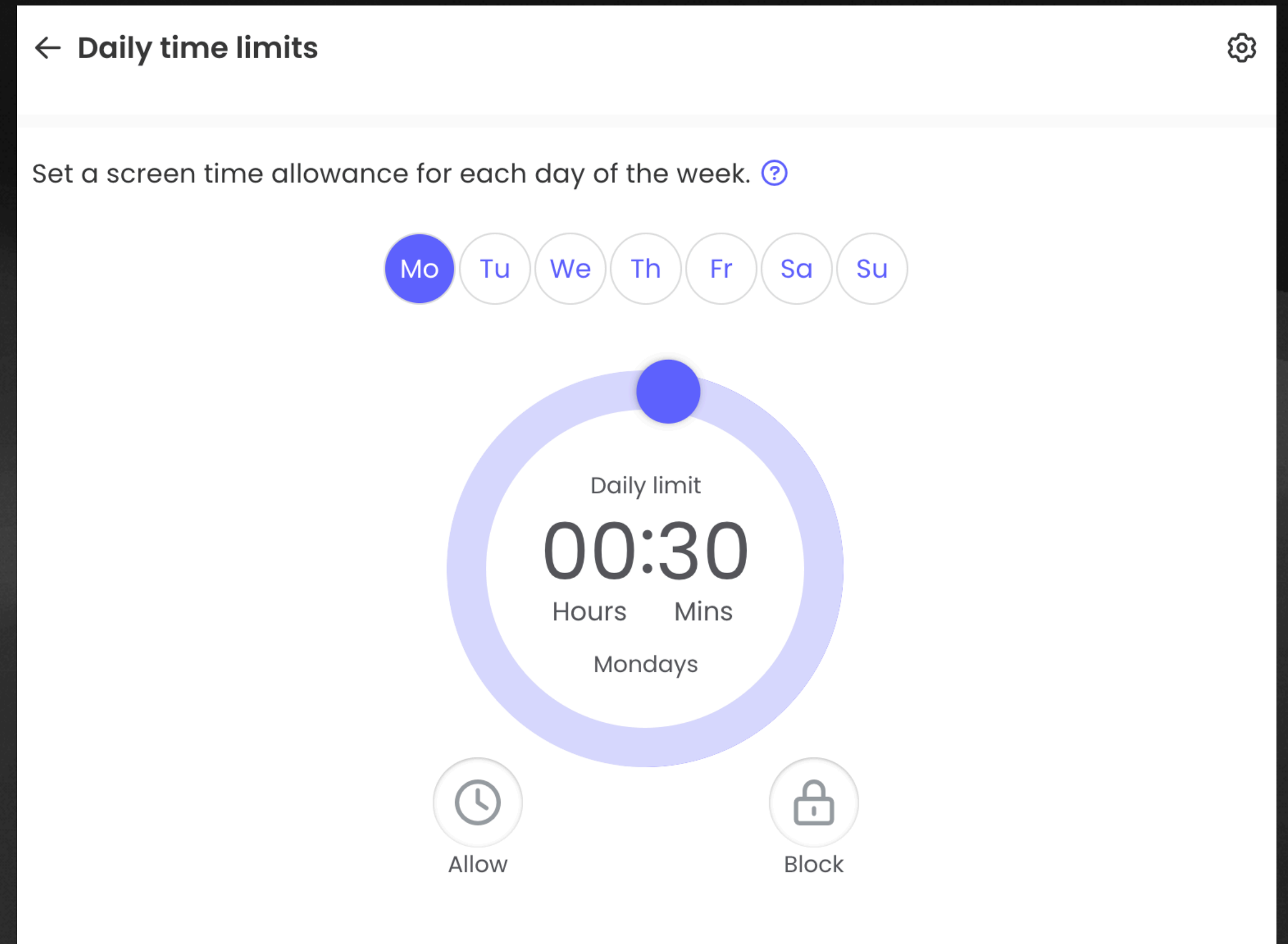
Bedtime Rules

- Select Edit rules in the bedtime routine
- Either block Internet only, or block access to all apps as well



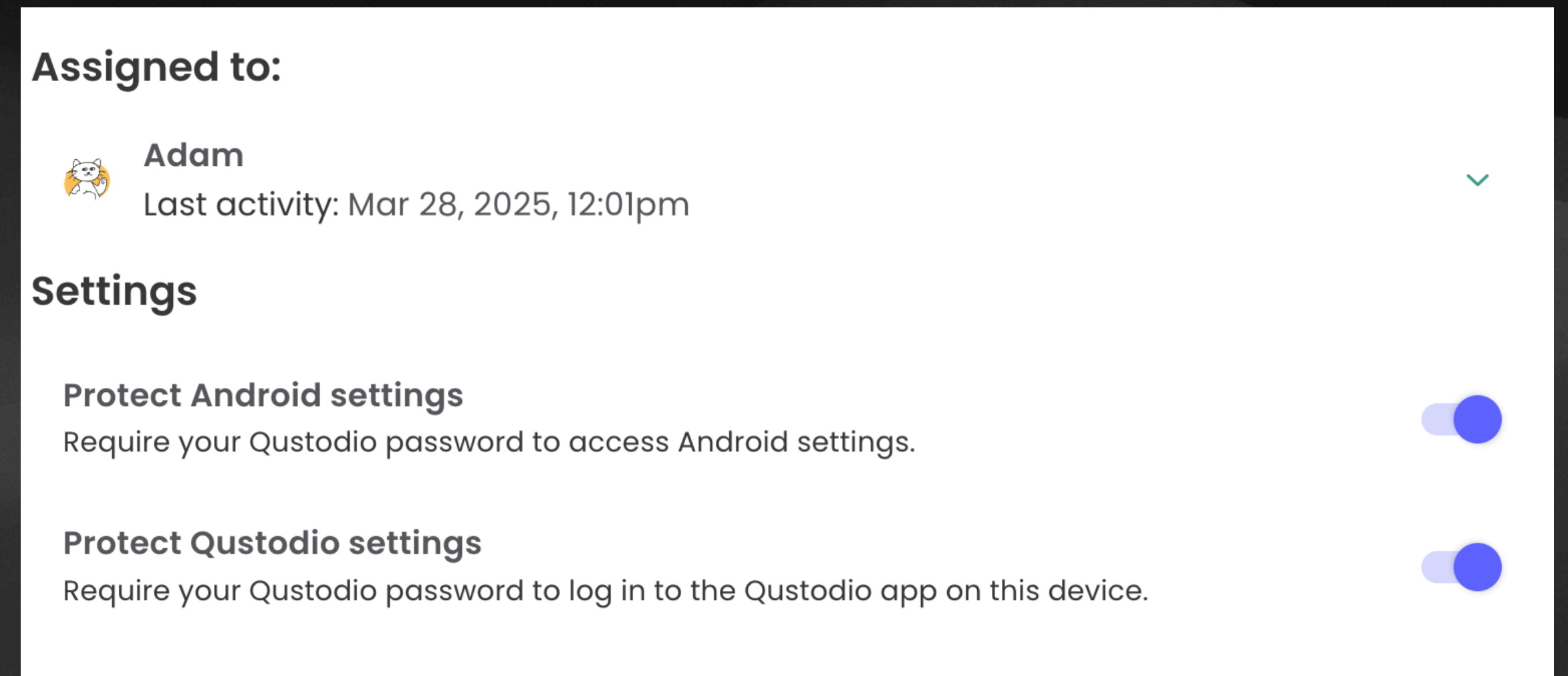
Daily Time Limits

- Go to My family > [child's name] > Rules > Daily time limits
- Click on each day of the week, and set how much screen time is allowed each day



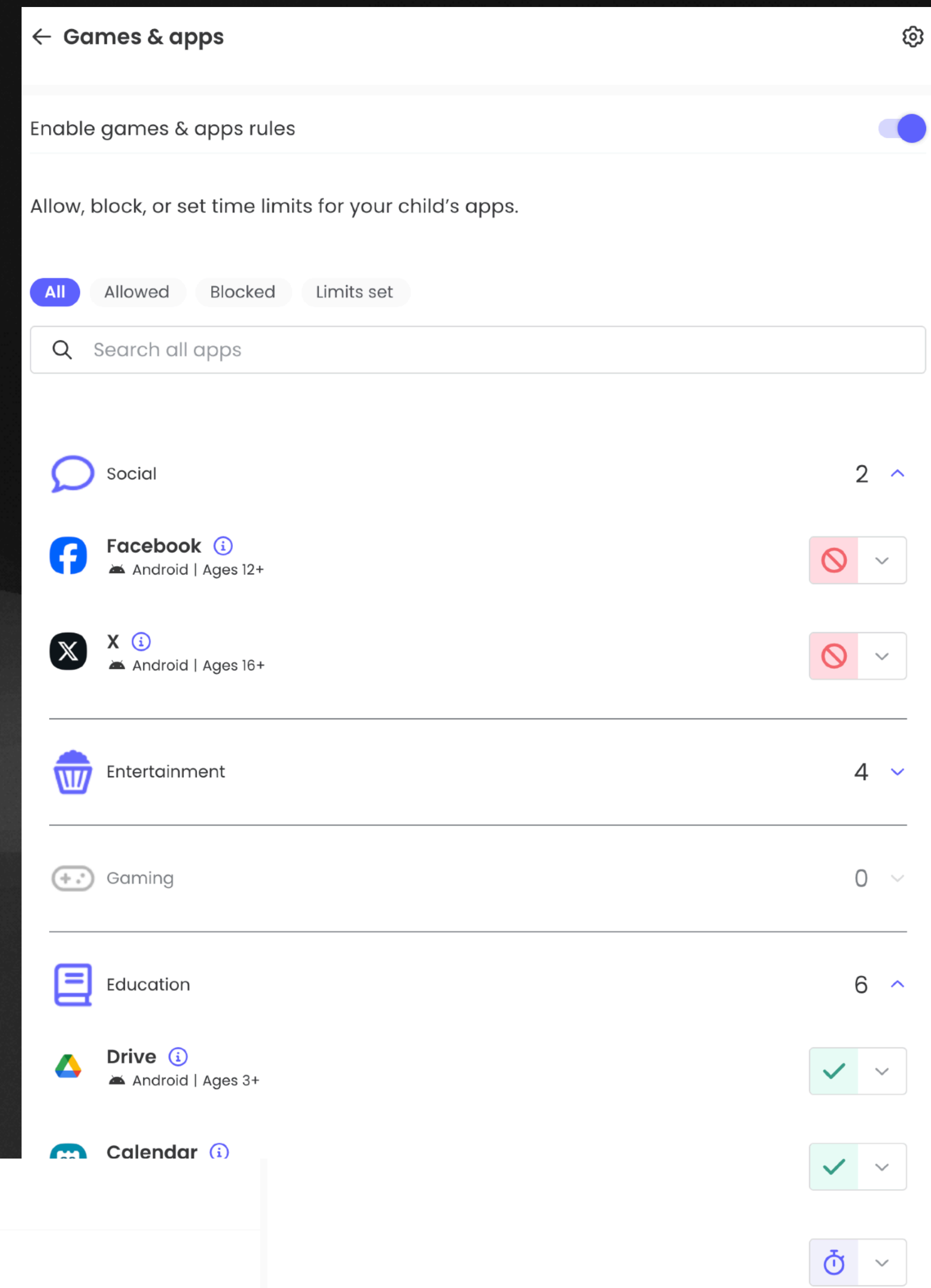
Limit Settings Access

- Go to Devices > [device name]
- Enable
 - Protect Android settings
 - Protect Qustodio settings
- Protecting Android settings will prevent the child from changing the device passcode



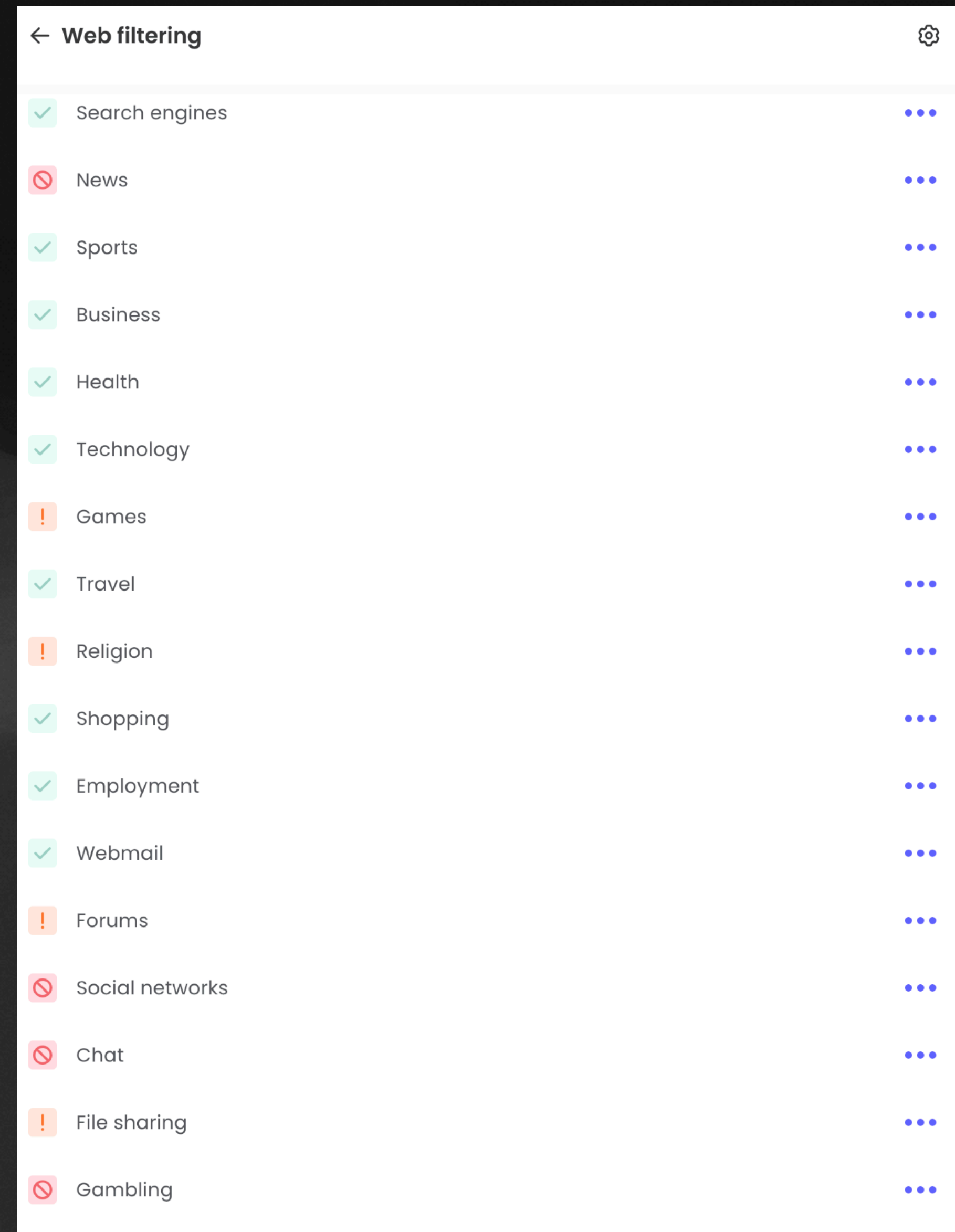
Block, Allow, and Limit Apps

- Go to My family > [child's name] > Rules > Games & apps
- This will show all apps installed on the phone
- You can block apps, allow, or set an app specific time limit
- Under settings enable the “Alert me” option to be notified when the child installs a new app



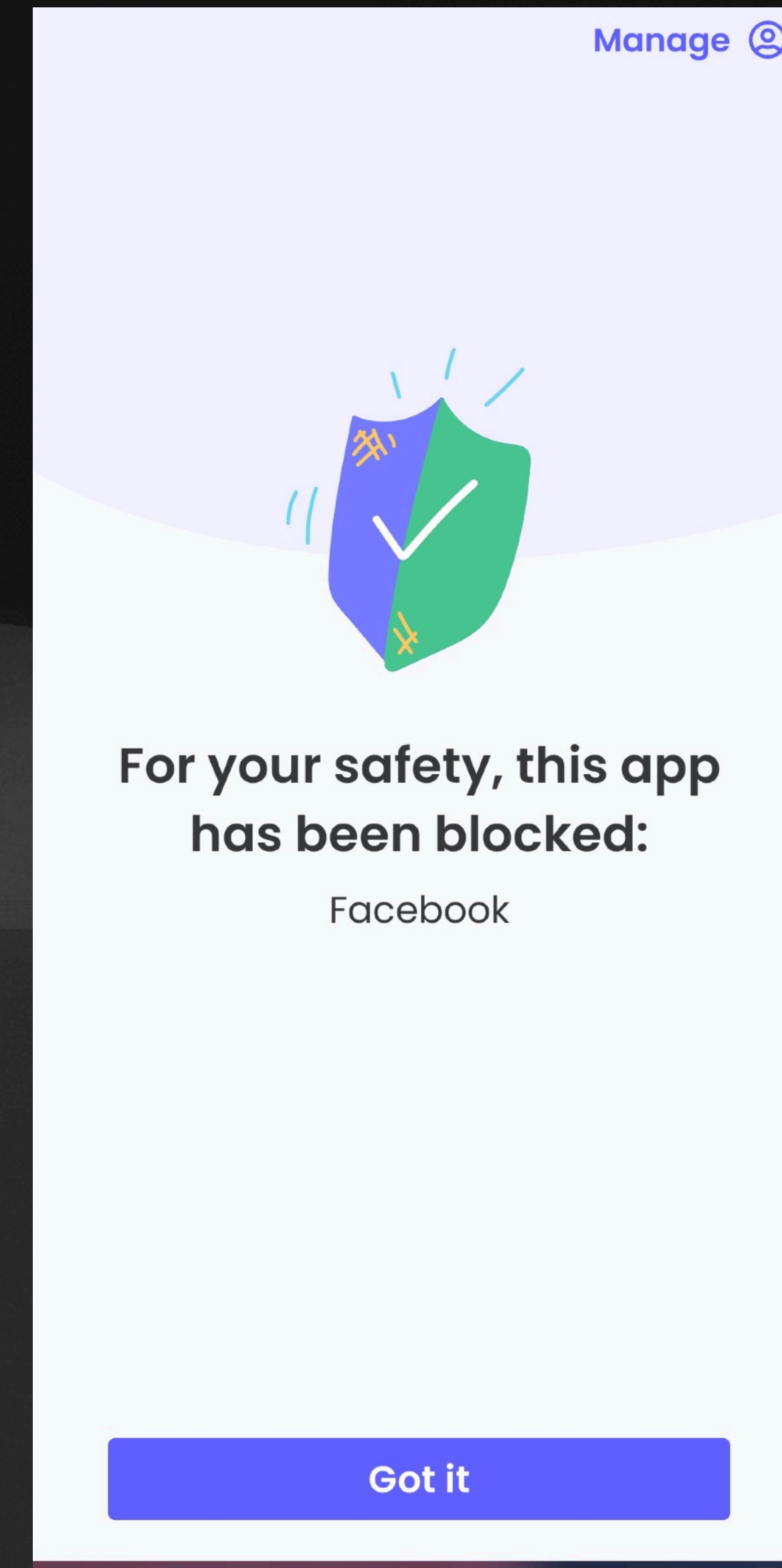
Web Filtering

- Go to My family > [child's name] > Rules > Web filtering
- You can allow, block, or set to be alerted if the child tries to access web sites in various categories
- On the Websites tab you can add rules for specific web sites as well



What the Child Sees on a Block

- The child will see a safety block when they try to open an app that has been blocked by the parent



Limitations

- No approval request method for new app installs
- No ability to manage child's contacts
- The whole Settings app has to be protected to prevent passcode changes
